

Walter King Gives Lay Delegate Report

Walter King, Camphor's lay delegate to Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference, provided an insightful report to the congregation of the 221st Session of the Annual Conference during today's worship service. The conference was held on June 13-15, 2007 at the Sheraton Hotel in center city Philadelphia. He stated that the conference theme, "Living Connected as God's People: Nurturing the Connection," was presented through worship, music and holy conferencing under the dynamic leadership of Bishop Marcus Matthews.

He reported that both the clergy and lay sessions were well attended. **Dr. Mary White**, led the laity session that featured the conference keynote speaker, **Sandy Zeigler Jackson**, Director of Lay Leadership Development, Nashville, TN, whose message, "Six Tools for Effective Leadership" was well received. He also found the array of luncheon workshops to be relevant and thought-provoking.

Highlights of the conference were the memorial service message brought by **Bishop Gregory Palmer**, Resident Bishop of the Iowa Conference, who was born and raised in Philadelphia, and the son of our former pastor, **Rev. Herbert Palmer**, and the dynamic opening of the conference worship service led by our **Camphor Praise Dancers** and the Ridge Avenue UMC Praise Team. Photos of the Praise Dancers are featured on the cover of the June 14, 2007 "New Spirit," the official EPC newsletter.

Mr. King completed his report by highlighting each of the "Six Tools for Effective Leadership," as presented by the conference keynote speaker: holy living, study and renewal, servant leadership, mission and vision, working together, and leading meaningful meetings. He also relayed the considerable discussion at Annual Conference on the decline of membership in the United Methodist Church. Since Camphor is also among the churches with declining memberships with no baptisms and memberships on profession of faith, Mr. King stated that Camphor must change by having meaningful worship services that are inviting to our diverse community and that Camphor's leaders and congregation must work together to identify and implement goals to make disciples of Jesus Christ. He thanked everyone for the opportunity to serve Camphor and prayed for wisdom to make the right changes.
