

Worship Survey Results Are In!

Floretta McMillon, Chairperson of the Worship Committee has provided a summary of the worship survey that was conducted in May-June 2007. The committee was pleased that a significant 31.6% of the 259 members of the church and over 70% of actual worshippers (82 people) responded to the survey. Generally, above average to high ratings were given to sermons, praise dancers, ushers and

worship bulletins. Areas identified for improvement were music, worship leaders, pulpit participants, lay announcements, offering procedures and hospitality. 63 persons stated that they would participate in a contemporary worship service.

Mrs. McMillon told *The Camphor Light* that the Worship Committee has been meeting with the pastor, music directors, and church leaders throughout the summer and it has resulted in the formation of a Worship Team who can help lead the services, identification of new worship and music resources that are needed (LCD projector, African-American Heritage Hymnals, etc) and selection of hymns, spirituals and gospel music for each service that are responsive to the needs of our diverse congregation. Mrs. McMillon states that many of the improvements will begin in October. A full copy of the survey and data may be obtained from the Worship Committee by contacting Mrs. McMillon.




