Church and Society Calls for Justice and Reconciliation in Jena

"Justice can lead to healing in Jena, Louisiana, but only if the intention is reconciliation," said United Methodist leaders responding to demonstrations in the small

Louisiana town. The Sept. 21 statement was issued by the United Methodist Board of Church and Society, the denomination's social action agency. It was in response to protests over six black students facing criminal prosecution in the beating of a white student. "Police intimidation, harsh prison sentences for youth, and different standards based on race will not lead to reconciliation," the statement said. "Justice and reconciliation can only be realized through an honest admission of the racism that exists in Jena and throughout the United States and the courage to bring about necessary changes to eradicate injustice which gives rise to violence."

The board's statement joins with those of other organizations - such as the Women's Division of the United Methodist Board of Global Ministries, Amnesty International and Human Rights Watch - in urging Louisiana Gov. Kathleen Blanco to ensure that the office of the State Attorney General and the Board of Education appropriately address the racially charged atmosphere in Jena.
